



INTRODUCTION

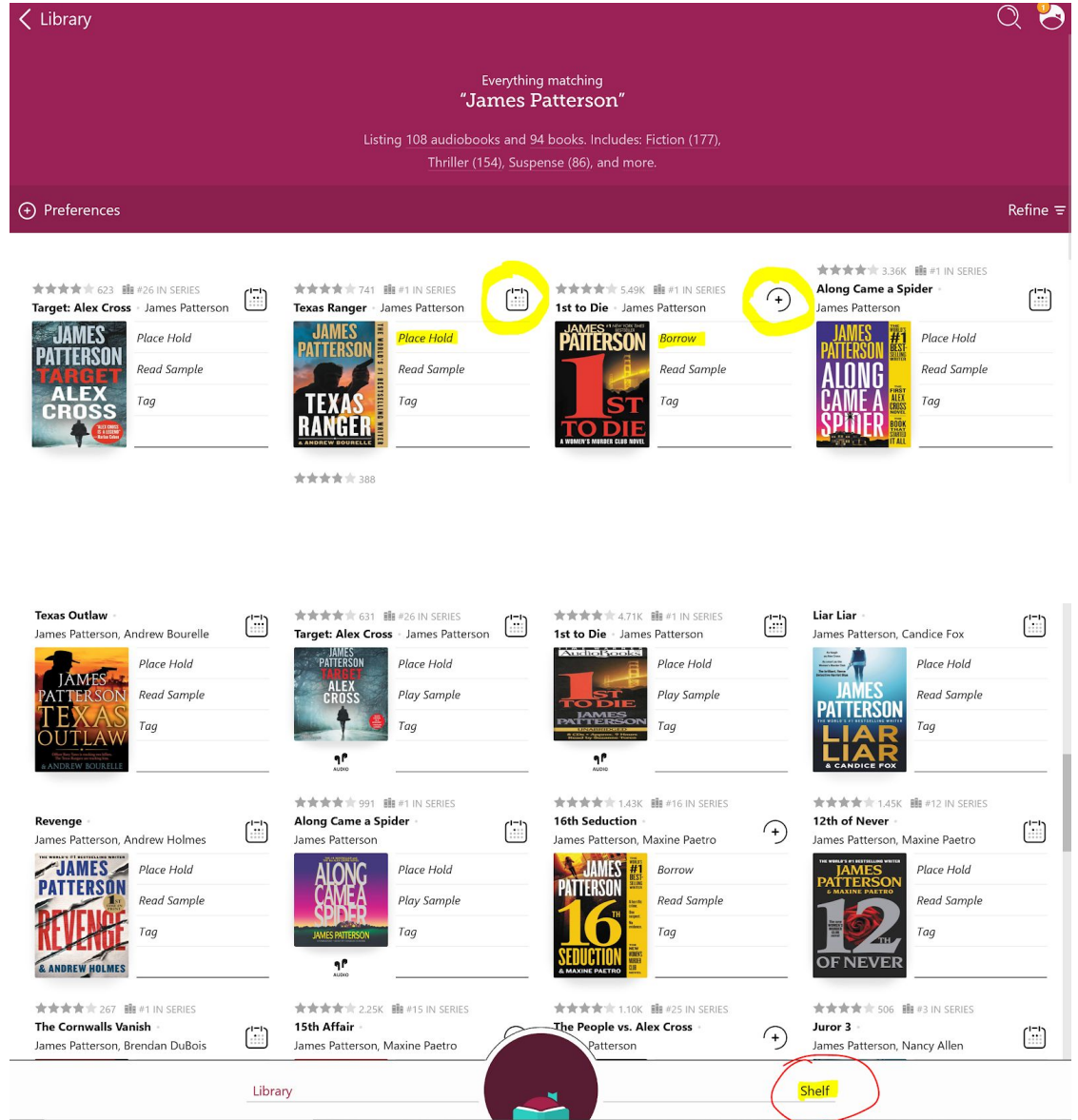
Have you met Libby yet? Libby is brought to you by OverDrive and allows you to browse thousands of eBooks and eAudiobooks from your local library. You can borrow them instantly and for free with any smart device.

GETTING STARTED WITH LIBBY

1. Install the Libby app from your device's app store.
2. Open the app and find your library. You can search by library name, city, or zip code.

3. When prompted, sign in. You'll need a valid library card and PIN. Once you are signed in, you can browse the library collection to find a title you would like to borrow. You can borrow up to 5 titles at one time.

4. You can tell if a book is available by looking next to its title. It will have a calendar icon if there is a wait list and a plus sign icon if you can borrow it immediately. eBooks will have a “Read Sample” button while eAudiobooks will have “Play Sample” button



5. Once you have borrowed a title, it will appear on your shelf located at the bottom of the page. If you download titles from a desktop, the titles will simultaneously download to the app so you can read them while you're offline.

6. From your shelf you can:

- Tap “Start Reading”, or “Start Listening” to open a title.
- Tap the book cover, then “Send to Device” to send a book to Kindle. If using this step, you will need to have your Amazon login.
